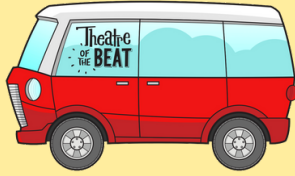

## DESCRIPTION & LEARNING GOALS

Participants will:

- Explore the idea of art as a tool for peacemaking
- Learn about the work of a variety of artist-activists from around the world
- Be given the opportunity to respond creatively to social justice themes through the form of theatre
- Harness their own creative potential for a more peaceable world

- An energetic drama-based warm up
- Exploration of the meaning of "peace"
- A "Gallery Walk" to view pictures of different types of art from around the world
- Exploration of theatrical elements:
  - Tableau
  - Soundscape
  - Movement
- A devised theatre activity culminating in a mini final performance!
